China Medical University is located in Shenyang, Liaoning province.

It was one of the earliest schools that delivered college education of western medicine in China. It was founded in November of 1931 with the approval of The Central Military Commission in Ruijin of Jiangxi province which was the birthplace of the Provisional Central Government of the Soviet Republic of China.

CMU has fostered and educated more than 100 thousand senior medical professionals since its founding. Its graduates are all over China and many other countries and regions, many of whom have become senior leaders in national health management and famous medical experts.

Education in CMU



CMU has a long history of strong teaching and scientific research with many talented people and abundant educational resources for international students, and has made great progress in education for international students through years of efforts.

- 1976** began to recruit Chinese government scholarship international students
- 1987** began to recruit graduate students
- 2005** began to recruit undergraduate students in MBBS taught fully in English
- 2016** began to recruit medical postgraduates taught fully in English
- 2018** began to recruit undergraduate students in BDS taught fully in English





School Conditions

The school library is very modernized With abundant collection, providing students with a beautiful and comfortable learning environment. At the same time, the public teaching building and teaching building for international students can fully meet the needs of daily teaching.

Laboratory

The University has 643 training rooms with a total area of 35,456 square meters. There are two national experimental teaching demonstration centers, eight provincial experimental teaching demonstration centers, three provincial virtual simulation centers, three provincial practice teaching bases and one provincial cross-professional training platform.





Teaching Hospital

The University has 3 affiliated general hospitals and 2 specialized hospitals, with 11,120 open beds and 265 dental comprehensive treatment chairs. The clinical practice of the international students in our university is arranged in the First Hospital of CMU 、 the Shengjing Hospital of CMU and the Stomatological Hospital of CMU.



In the Fudan version of "2019 China Hospital Rankings" published in 2020, the First Hospital of CMU ranked **17th** in the country, and the Shengjing Hospital of CMU ranked **38th**. The Hospital of Stomatology was ranked **9th** in the rankings for the stomatology speciality

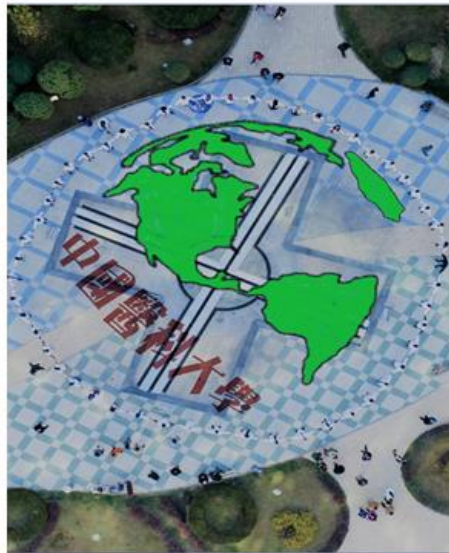

Entry Requirements

To be eligible for a program of study at China Medical University, international students need to meet both the general and specific entry requirements. These requirements differ depending on the level of the program you've applied to ,and also what is required by the school.

★ Applications are open to foreign citizens with reliable financial support and stability who are senior-high-school graduates with an age above 18 and in good health. Applicants should have no record of violation of discipline, punishment for public security, and criminal conduct. Applicants should have friendly feelings towards China and good conduct. They should comply with Chinese laws and university regulations, and respect Chinese culture and traditions.

★ Applicants who were Chinese citizens and have immigrated to a foreign country &

Applicants have foreign nationality at birth, whose parents are both Chinese citizens, or one of the parents is an Chinese citizen,

should hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for 4 or more years, and have a record proving that the applicants have stayed abroad for more than 2 years during the last 4 years (staying abroad for over 9 months in a year will be counted as one year and calculation of the duration of stay will be based on the entry and exit stamps).



Master Programs

- Hold a bachelor degree;
- Below 35 years old;

Doctoral Programs

- Hold a master degree;
- Below 40 years old;

Undergraduate program

- High school graduate or above;
- Age from 18-25 years old;
- Examination results in physics, chemistry and biology should be better than average;
- HSK certificate at Level 4 or above (for Chinese-taught program applicants);
- English language proficiency: for non-native English speakers who apply for English-taught programs, they should submit the IELTS /TOFEL result or other certificate to certify their English level. The result should be above 85(New TOFEL) or 6.0(IELTS).



Documentary requirements

1. Scanned copy of the passport.
2. Senior high school transcripts and graduation diploma (Students expecting to graduate should provide an official letter stating the expected graduation date, and submit the graduation diploma if admitted), which should be the original documents or certified copies in Chinese or English.
3. Letter of financial support and Bank statement.
4. HSK score report (for Chinese-taught program applicants).
5. TOEFL/IELTS or other score reports of English language test (for English-taught program applicants whose native/official language is not English).
6. For applicants whose age is under 18 and parents are not resident in China, their parents must formally entrust a foreigner or Chinese resident in China as the guardian of the applicants and provide relevant entrusted materials.
7. Besides the above documents, the applicants for master degree and doctoral degree programs need to submit a personal statement, which should include study and work experience, reasons for application and study proposal, two letters of recommendation from professors or associate professors (in Chinese or English). The letters must include professors' phone number and email address. And an acceptance letter from CMU supervisor.

Application Procedure



1. Access the online application system (<https://cmu.17gz.org/member/login.do>) to make your application.

The application system is accessible from February to June 2021 .

2. After receiving the application, CMU will examine the application materials. For applicants who have passed the application document examination and online interview, CMU will issue electronic acceptance letters.
3. Once receiving the acceptance letters, applicants shall pay full tuition fees for the first year (not refundable) within a given time, and upload the remittance letter to the application system.
4. For applicants who have paid in full, CMU will issue an “Visa Application Form for Study in China” (JW202 form) and “Admission Notice letter”.
5. Students holding “Admission Notice letter” and “Visa application Form for Study in China” (JW202 form) issued by our school can apply for X1 visa to study in China at the People's Republic of China Embassy or Consulates.

After you've been admitted

Medical Insurance

All international students in China must apply for medical insurance in accordance with the relevant regulations of the People's Republic of China and the school. If the insurance is not purchased within the time limit, the school will not admit the applicants or cancel the enrollment qualification.

Accommodation

CMU have two dormitory buildings for international students on campus. Students will live in single rooms attached with bathroom and other necessary facilities. There are coin-operated washing machines in the dormitory building. There is also a public kitchen on each floor in the dorms. Students can cook the traditional food by themselves.

For students who enter the clinical course learning stage, they will study in the school's affiliated hospital, the school will no longer provide dormitories, students need to move off campus to rent their own house.

Registration

1. Admitted applicants should register at the school within the specified time and complete the enrollment procedures according to the admission notice. Those who are unable to register on time for some reasons should submit an application for postponement of registration to the school in advance. It is deemed to have waived the admission qualification automatically if the applicants leave or leave overdue for more than two weeks (10 working days)) except for some legitimate reasons such as force majeure.

2. After the enrollment, students must undergo a review of admission qualifications. If fraudulent or tampering with application materials is found during the application process, their admission qualifications will be cancelled. All responsibilities and consequences arising therefrom shall be borne by the applicant.
